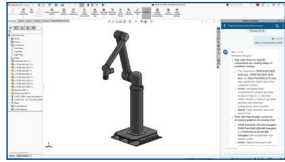

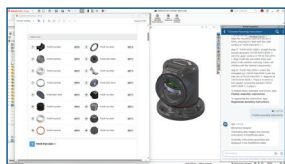

Assembly Performance Optimization

Find and fix your biggest assembly slowdowns first, without manual trial and error.



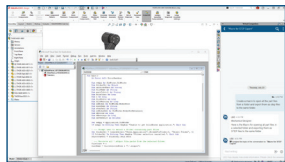

Produce consistent assembly instructions in minutes instead of hours of manual work.



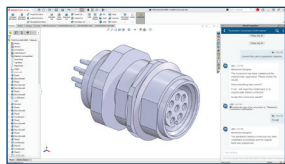

Automate repetitive tasks without writing a single line of code.



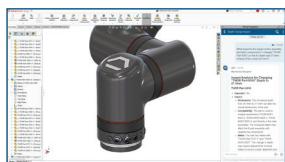

BREP-to-Parametric Conversion

Turn imported geometry into a fully editable design, not a dead end.



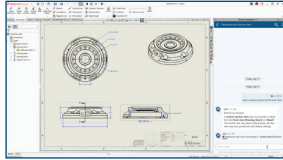

Change Impact Analysis

Catch costly dependency issues before you commit to a change.

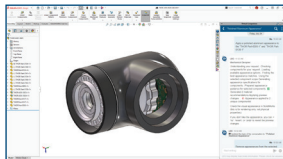


6 Automated Drawing Generation

Cut manual setup time when creating drawings.

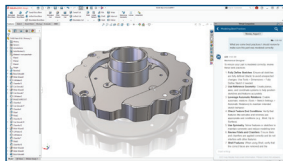


7 Automated Material Appearances

Save time on repetitive material appearance assignments.

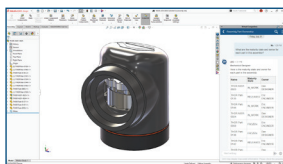


8 SOLIDWORKS Guidance

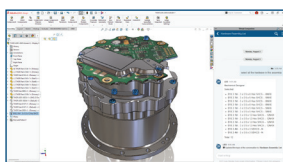


9 PLM Insights
